across the system. There is hope that this LPN program will feed into
those programs. This is a program that Fairbanks Memorial Hospital and
Tanana Chiefs asked the University to create. The concern would be that
without this program they would need to go to outside institutions to hire
LPNs for Alaska. The role of the procost is critical as they are aware of all
new programs as they approve.
