Faculty has suffered a tremendous loss of purchasing power. There has only been a 1% raise in the last six years. Inflation is running 8% or 9%. Meeting this agreement would show their faith and trust back into faculty. The resolution passed unanimously.

B. Thanksgiving Holiday Name Change: (Q from Andrea: since UAS already all agreed to call this Fall Break can we do this locally (esp. Since the name of the holiday isn't in policy?)

Megan Busby who chairs the Common Calendar Committee says the issue

is not within the domain of the common calendar committee. Although there was support for it amongst the talk of the committee.

This issue will be taken to the Faculty Senates as there is support for it.

Some board members have the opinion of a more uniform approach and other board members have an approach of differentiation and strength. The tuition motion will keep UAS and UAA tuition flat again. This was an informational item.
