2) ITIN feedback from HR: I believe true ITINs are being recorded in Glacier. However, in looking at the data in Banner there have been more than 4,300 recorded in Banner (students or employees). Most of these are from 2009 and before. I believe Glacier was implemented in 2010.

It is my understanding that tax reporting documents, such as 1042S, are generated and supplied from Glacier and that an ITIN is a number issued by the IRS for tax reporting purposes only.

An employee's ITIN is stored in Glacier. Glacier issues the completed 1042-S form (which is similar to a W-2 for US citizens) for non-US citizen tax reporting to the IRS. The non-US citizen does not receive a W-2. There have been no employees since 2009 with a recorded ITIN number in Banner (SSN field or otherwise). If I were to make an educated guess, my first one would be that the few people in Banner with an ITIN in the SSN field might have been either students or vendors that received or should receive a 1099 misc income form for tax reporting, but Laura should be able to elaborate on whether that's a possibility.
