Opportunity Overview:

The Arctic Leadership Initiative is searching for undergraduate and graduate students to participate in an Arctic Leadership Initiative student cohort. This Spring, the student cohort will meet monthly with postdocs and early career faculty in the initiative to develop networking skills. The cohort will also attend a leadership retreat and Arctic Encounters Symposium in Anchorage from April 1-4, 2025 where they will meet with Arctic leaders from around the world.



Eligibility:

- Must be able to attend full-day retreat in Anchorage April 1, 2025
- Must be able to attend Arctic Encounter Symposium in Anchorage April, 2-4, 2025
- Any graduate or undergraduate student of any major at junior or senior class status at any University of Alaska campus; priority given to graduate students and under graduates of junior or senior class status
- Enrolled in at least one UA course in Spring 2025
- Must be 18 or older
- Must be able to attend a few specific, free lectures provided as a part of the Arctic Leadership course (PS 493 or PS 693) and attend monthly cohort discussions in the lead up to the April retreat and Arctic Encounter Symposium

- Tuition for Arctic Leadership course (PS 493 or PS 693)
- Travel, lodging, and registration paid to Anchorage for Arctic Encounter Symposium (April 2025) and cohort retreat (April 1, 2025)
