- Roll and Call to Order The meeting came to order at 2:36 p.m. Quorum was met.
- 2. Review of Agenda

Members reviewed the agenda. Chris noted he added a new item regarding the Faculty Initiative Fund. There were no objections to the agenda as presented.

- Approve <u>October 26 Minutes</u> No objections to the minutes as presented.
- 4. Pubic and Guest Comments None given.

- 5. Chair's Report
  - a. Update: November 8-9 BOR meeting John Davies will serve as chair for 2019. The regents passed the new policy on reports of misconduct as it was presented. Students, faculty and staff representatives gave feedback and requested a timeframe that better reflected the amount of time students spend at the university. Regents also heard from consultants with <u>NCHEMS</u> regarding Board authority and best processes.
  - b. OpEd Letters: Chair report he sent out the op-ed letters this Wednesday and heard back from the Ketchikan Daily News which will publish it, the Homers News which opted not to publish, the Alaska Business Monitor which will publish next week, and the Alaska Journal of Commerce who will also publish the letter shortly.
- 6. Senate Reports
  - a. UAS Met on Nov. 2. UAS held its Power and Privilege Symposium this week -Matthew Shepard's parents attended as did <u>Oscar Vasquez</u>. Curriculum committee met - moved forward several occupational endorsements. Also wrote a resolution regarding the new policy on reports of misconduct. Concerns about developing dual enrollment further without adequate faculty involvement.

  - c. UAF Met on Nov. 5. Passed two bylaw changes accreditation review and committee and ad hoc committee to review student bereavement policy. UAF strategic planning process was introduced by administrators. Strategic enrollment planning initiative is also underway and plan to hear from the VC for Students in December. Two guests attended--the staff council president discussed a recent staff morale survey, and then VP Layer who discussed service and maintaining flexibility with service assignments as well as the possibility of setting a lower default for service. Time with VP Layer also included discussion of adjuncts (should use of adjuncts be reduced? If so, should adjuncts be converted to tenure track positions?) and mentoring for postdocs who move into research faculty roles. Also recent announcement that F&A rates are also going to be increased, possibly from 50% to 63%, although the final rate has not yet been determined.
- 7. New Business
  - a. GERM Committee planning discussion (See worksheet in the Scorecard)

Members reviewed current list of possible committee members and discussed the best way forward. Agreed to invite the three chairs of the individual GER committees to attend an upcoming Faculty Alliance meeting.

Chair noted VP Layer was supportive of most of the proposed changes, however, there were a few he items he requested additional review/edits. Members reviewed the RFP again and made several changes including how many projects on which a faculty member can serve (PI on one and co-PI on one) and when they will receive salary, as well as how much can be paid to collaborators not affiliated with the UA system.
