- 1. Roll and Call to Order
 - The meeting came to order at 2:31 p.m. and quorum was met.
- 2. Review of Agenda

Members reviewed the agenda and had no changes. Agenda was adopted as presented.

3. Approve <u>February 8</u> Minutes

Members reviewed the draft minutes and had no corrections. The minutes were approved as presented.

5. Chair's Report

- a. Report to the Board of Regents
- b. Updates: Chris attended the BOR ASA committee meeting on Feb. 21. He noted Regent Hargraves attended and asked questions about process, and Regent Perdue asked for more information on several program discontinuations and accreditation processes. Discussion about <u>UAA SOE accreditation</u> regents heard options from UA administration including expedited program review, applying for accreditation in 2020, or opting to end UAA's SOE programs altogether.

6. Senate Reports

- a. UAS: Will meet next Friday; draft alcohol and marijuana regulations as well as a couple other policies including transfer; also looking at writing placement exam; still working on AK Native GER requirement; dual enrollment forum was really useful and was thankful UAA KPC faculty could answer their questions
- b. UAF: Will meet in early March; considering a certificate in cyber security; of course waiting on more guidance about the FY20 budget
- c. UAA: Will meet next Friday and they are still focusing on UAA SOE--still reeling from the negative PR from that; met with Chancellor Sandeen last week and she wants to pursue re-accreditation (perhaps not for all programs that lost accreditation); budget discussion on how to develop a sustainable budget so that UAA isn't so dependent on the state appropriation every year; all term faculty have received letters stating their positions might not return next year (adjunct faculty are also likely vulnerable); overall, the faculty at UAA feel they are on the outside of decision making and that is increasing anxiety; UAA Faculty Senate is also considering a resolution in support of seeking re-accreditation for the SOE; also working on constitution and bylaws revision

Members discussed the proposed regulations and draft memo from Chris. After making some edits to the fieldwork section, Megan moved to approve, seconded. The memo was approved and will be sent to Saichi.
