Charge to the working group: "To propose the shared structure of the BOR GER requirement and explain how this articulates with each universities GER/core program, and to propose and recommend new policy for the BOR to consider for GERs."

Deadlines: Interim report in March 2015. Final report November 2015. BOR resolution states: "and propose a plan of implementation for other areas of general education (humanities and fine arts, natural sciences, and social sciences) by fall 2016;"
