Preliminary Applications, Admissions, Enrollment and Revenue Activity 3 Weeks Before Start of Fall Instruction August 7, 2023

The information below compares preliminary fall 2023 and 2022 semester activity relative to the first day of instruction and provides a working estimate of final fall 2023 closing enrollment levels. The fall 2023 semester starts in 3 weeks.

Final fall 2023 closing enrollment projections were revised upward this week, reflecting the most up-to-date activity and course registration patterns over time. At this point in the semester, about two-thirds of all students who will enroll by December have already registered. Compared to last year, more than 700 (3.5%) additional students are anticipated to enroll by December 2023 for a total headcount of about 20,900. Student credit hour (SCH) registration is expected to grow by more than 6,100 SCH (3.7%) from last year, reaching an estimated 170,600 SCH by the end of the term. The graphs on pages 6 and 7 display historical and current course registration patterns for headcount and SCH, respectively.

As of August 7, 2023, 13,863 students registered for 135,711 fall semester credit hours, system wide. This represents a 4 percent increase in headcount (535 students) and a 5 percent increase in student credit hour registration (6,678 SCH) over this time last year. UAA student headcount is 3 percent (224 students) higher and student credit hour registration is 2 percent higher (1,756 SCH) than last year at this time. UAF enrolled 7 percent (357) more students in 11 percent (4,985) more credit hours compared to fall 2022. UAS headcount has increased 4 percent (53 students) and student credit hour registration is up more than 1 percent (117 SCH), year-over-year. Additional detail about underlying student headcount and student credit hour changes by academic unit and campus may be found on page 2.

Currently, total net tuition and fee revenue is up more than 6 percent (\$3.1M) system wide over fall 2022. Undergraduate tuition revenue rose nearly 7 percent (\$2.0M) and graduate tuition revenue by more than 8 percent (\$313.0 thousand) compared to last year. UAA revenue is up close to 3 percent (\$0.7M), UAF revenue is up almost 13 percent (\$2.3M), and UAS revenue is up slightly compared to this time last year. This week a new report format for applications, admissions and program majors is presented to better align with current operational practices (pages 4-5). Nearly 10,700 applications have been initiated by prospective students for admission in fall 2023, up 11 percent (about 1,100 applications) from fall 2022. A total of 3,336 admitted program majors have elected to enroll at the university they were accepted into for fall. First-time, prospective students have initiated more than 5,860 applications to at least one program for fall 2023; 70 percent of these applications have been completed by the prospective student and accepted for admission.


