

Preliminary Admissions, Course Registration and Billed Revenue

Fall 2024 Semester - July 17, 2024

This report compares activity 6 weeks prior to the start of Fall 2024 and Fall 2023 semesters, normalized relative to the first day of instruction for a given term. Fall 2023 semester began August 28, 2023, and Fall 2024 instruction will begin August 26, 2024. Trends are preliminary.

Applications

More than 11,900 applications have been initiated by prospective students for Fall 2024, up 22.5 percent (2,186 applications) from Fall 2023. Increases were observed at UAA of 6.4 percent (383 applications), UAF of 55.4 percent (1,880 applications), and UAS of 2.0 percent (14 applications) over last year. The subset of applications initiated by prospective first-time students account for 63.2 percent of application activity, to-date, with growth of 9.5 percent (346 applications) at UAA; 102.1 percent (1,777 applications) at UAF, and 6.4 percent (26 applications) at UAS, year-over-year.

Course Registration

With 6 weeks to go before the start of Fall 2024 instruction, 12,126 students have registered for 120,893 student credit hours (SCH) - a 4.8 percent increase in headcount (558 students) and a 5.3 percent increase in SCH registration (6,136 SCH) year over year.

Graphs displaying historical and current course registration patterns for headcount and SCH are provided on pages 5 and 6, respectively. Nationally, undergraduate headcount at public, baccalaureate granting institutions grew 1.2 percent and graduate level enrollment 3 percent, in the last year*.

As of Wednesday, UAA headcount was 6.8 percent higher (428 students) and SCH was 7.6 percent higher (4,652 SCH) than last year. Most UAA academic units have additional SCH registration for Fall 2024 compared to last year. The School of Arts and Sciences accounted for 29 percent (1,332) and Kenai Peninsula College 27 percent (1,260) of overall UAA growth in SCH registration.

UAF headcount increased 2.6 percent (121 students), with students registering in about 2.4 percent more (1,079) SCH year-over-year. Nearly all Troth Yeddha' academic units have additional SCH registration, beyond the level observed this time last year. Overall, course registration growth of more than 1,000 SCH at the College of Natural Sciences offset a decline of similar magnitude at the Career and Technical College.

At UAS, student headcount increased 6.1 percent (61 students) from Fall 2023, and student credit hour registration increased by 5.0 percent (405 SCH). Juneau and Ketchikan academic units show additional SCH registration, year over year. A gain of almost 500 SCH at the School of Arts & Sciences was partially balanced by a decline of about 260 SCH at Sitka campus compared to last year, on the whole.

Billed Tuition and Fees - Estimated Revenue

Total fall semester net tuition and fees billed to registered students, to-date, is estimated to be about 6.6 percent (\$2.9M) higher this year than last. UAA billed net tuition and fees increased 8.0 percent (\$1.7M), and UAF increased by 5.0 percent (\$0.9M) over Fall 2023. Currently, UAS tuition and fee revenue is 6.5 percent (\$0.2M) higher than last year at this time. Additional tuition and fees detail by university and revenue category is available on page 3.

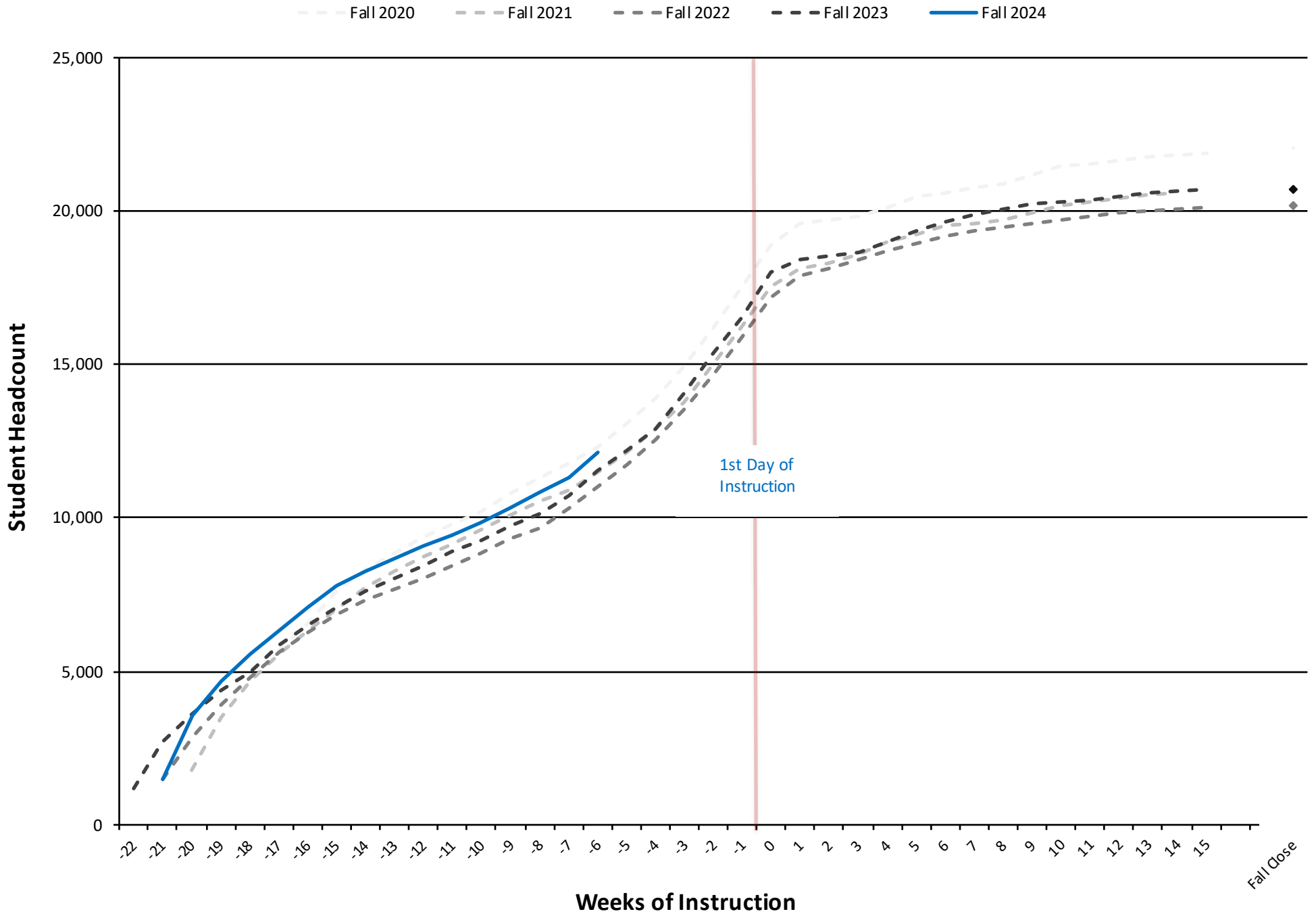
