# Preliminary Applications, Admissions, Enrollment and Revenue Activity 7 Weeks Before Start of Fall Instruction July 10, 2023

The following is a comparison of student activity 7 weeks prior to the first day of instruction for fall 2022 and fall 2023 semesters. Note, working estimates of final fall 2023 enrollment are more conservative than current weekly trends, year-over-year, in part because semester registration opened one week earlier for fall 2023 than for fall 2022.

Looking forward to December, closing headcount is expected to reach the same level as last year with about 20,250 students enrolled. An increase of more than 1 percent in student credit hour (SCH) registration (2,100) is anticipated, with students attempting an estimated 166,650 SCH by the close of fall 2023 (see pages 4-5).

Current year-over-year revenue growth is also expected to moderate some by the close of the semester, in alignment with anticipated final enrollment levels. Currently, total net tuition and fee revenue is up 7 percent (\$2.8M) from fall 2022, with over two-thirds (\$1.9M) from undergraduate course tuition. UAA revenue is about the same as this time last year, UAF revenue is up almost 21 percent (\$3.1M) and UAS revenue is down 8 percent (\$239.8 thousand). The total number of program applications is up almost 10 percent (949 applications) over this time last year. Undergraduate program applications for fall 2023 are up across the board, 11 percent (582) at UAA, 8 percent (219) at UAF and almost 3 percent (19) at UAS. The proportion of all applications that have been accepted for fall 2023 semester is about 3 percent higher than for fall 2022.

About 36 percent (2,270 of 6,305) of newly admitted undergraduate program majors have elected to enroll for fall 2023, along with 55 percent (229 of 414) of newly admitted graduate program majors. The number of all newly admitted degree seeking students that registered for courses grew nearly 19 percent (191) at UAA, 13 percent (131) at UAF and over 3 percent (5) at UAS from fall 2022. As of July 10, 2023, a total of 10,612 students had registered for 106,050 fall semester student credit hours, equivalent to 5 and 6 percent growth in system wide headcount and student credit hours from last year, respectively. Underlying enrollment trends vary by individual university, with UAF enrolling 15 percent (562) more students year-over-year, UAA holding steady (up 11 students) and UAS student headcount declining 4 percent (34 students). 
