## Fall 2023 Course Enrollment and Revenue Activity Near Final - January 2, 2024

Information presented here reflects near-final fall semester 2023 data in UA information systems as of January 2, 2024. Fall semester student information may continue to be added through January 12, $2024^{1}$. Updates made after the end of the semester are typically small in magnitude and primarily reflect information about postsecondary level courses delivered for dual credit in a high school. Final fall 2023 information will be widely available at the end of January.

Fall 2023 student headcount has reached almost 20,750, representing growth of 2.7 percent (542 students) system wide from fall 2022 and a return to the fall 2021 headcount level observed two years ago. UAA enrolled 11,940 students this fall, 5.1 percent (577) more than in fall 2022. UAF headcount reached 7,462 in fall 2023, representing growth of 0.5 percent ( 38 students) year-over-year. At UAS a total of 2,177 students enrolled for fall 2023 , up 2.0 percent ( 42 students) from fall 2022.

The number of student credit hours attempted in fall 2023 reached more than 170,500, up 3.7 percent ( 6,048 student credit hours) from fall 2022 and 0.9 percent $(1,474)$ from fall 2021 , system wide. UAA generated 96,504 student credit hours, 4.6 percent $(4,214)$ more than in fall 2022. Students attending UAF registered for 59,939 credit hours, growing 3.6 percent $(2,077)$ year-over-year. Student credit hour registration in UAS courses totaled 14,067, a decrease of 1.7 percent (242) compared to last year.

Billed, net tuition and fee revenue for fall 2023 is almost 5 percent ( $\$ 2.9 \mathrm{M}$ ) higher than in fall 2022. The revenue categories contributing the most to this overall growth were undergraduate tuition, up 4.7 percent $(\$ 1.7 \mathrm{M})$, and graduate tuition which increased 10.6 percent $(\$ 0.5 \mathrm{M})$.

UAA net tuition and fee revenue grew by 3.8 percent ( $\$ 1.2 \mathrm{M}$ ) from last fall, driven by increases in tuition revenue as well as non-resident tuition surcharge. UAF revenue for the semester increased 7.6 percent ( $\$ 1.7 \mathrm{M}$ ) over fall 2022, primarily from increased tuition and student fee revenue. UAS billed tuition and fee revenue for fall 2023 was just above the fall 2022 level, with growth in graduate level tuition revenue balancing nominal declines across other categories.

Fall 2022 semester instruction began Monday August 29 , 2022 and Fall semester 2023 instruction began Monday August 28, 2023. Comparable dates relative to each university's weeks to start of instruction are reported, and if not available the closest comparable date is selected. Headcount is unduplicated at the reporting level. Includes all for-credit course registration activity, regardless of a student's degree seeking status. Developmental, undergraduate, professional, and graduate level courses are included. Data is provided by UAA, UAF and UAS, extracted on the report date from UA information systems.
