

Preliminary Course Registration and Admission Activity, Spring 2025

Second Week of Instruction

January 20, 2025

This is a summary of Spring 2025 semester activity as of Monday, January 20, 2025; trend figures are normalized relative to the first day of instruction for Spring term. Students may initiate add/drop of full semester length classes through Friday, January 24, 2025¹. Students enrolling in short and late start classes will continue to drive additional enrollment until the end of the term.

Year-over-year course registration trends reported for the UA system, UA Anchorage, Prince William Sound College, Anchorage Campus and the UAA School of Education are impacted by UAA business practice refinements². Closing Outlook

Student credit hour registration is expected to increase 4.5 percent (7,300 SCH) over last year, reaching about 171,100 SCH by the end of term. Approximately 4,000 additional students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Spring 2025, for a total headcount of 21,600 students, reaching a level slightly higher (100 students) than in Spring 2024.

At this point, four out of five students who will likely enroll by the end of Spring 2025 have registered in an estimated 95 percent of Spring 2025 student credit hours (SCH). Course Registration

As of January 20, 2025, 17,607 students had registered for 162,229 Spring semester credit hours, system wide. This represents a small increase headcount (114 additional students) and a 5 percent (7,713 SCH) increase in student credit hour registration from the levels observed at the start of Spring 2024. UAA student headcount decreased about 1 percent (137 students) and student credit hours grew about 4 percent (3,379 SCH) compared to last year. UAF student headcount is approximately 4 percent (294 students) higher and student credit hour registration is nearly 8 percent (4,317 SCH) higher than Spring 2024. UAS headcount is almost 4 percent (66 students) lower and student credit hour registration remained nearly the same (17 SCH higher) compared to this time last year.

About four percent of students (763 individuals) enrolled to-date are taking classes concurrently at multiple universities within the system. See page 2 for additional detail about underlying student headcount and student credit hour changes by academic unit and campus.

Applications, Admissions and Enrolled Majors

More than 3,200 students applied and were accepted for admission in Spring 2025, up almost 6 percent (174 individuals) from this time last year. About 60 percent of applicants admitted to undergraduate programs and 80 percent of those admitted to graduate level programs have elected to enroll so far. Non-credit courses and courses administered in other student information systems other than Banner are not included. *Year-over-year course registration trends reported for the UA system, UA Anchorage, Prince William Sound College, Anchorage Campus and the UAA School of Education are impacted by recent UAA business practice refinements. These include reclassification of select for-credit courses to non-credit status as well as a transition of 500 level, for-credit professional development courses to a separate student information system, Genius, designed for professional development students. As of Spring 2024 opening, these courses constituted 11 and 6 percent of UAA and total UA System headcount, respectively, as well as 3 and 2 percent of UAA and total UA System SCH, respectively. 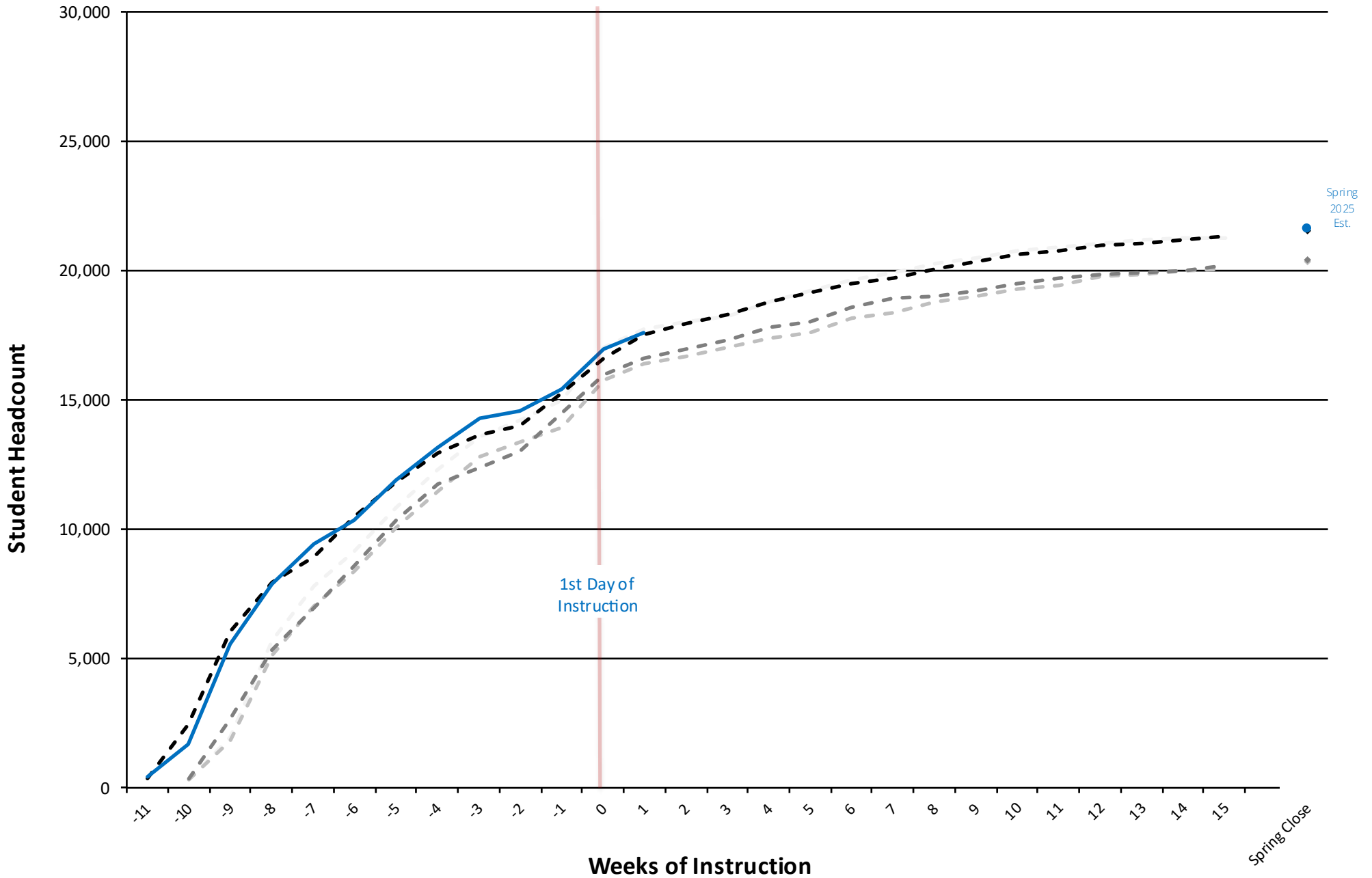
