

Preliminary Course Registration and Admission Activity, Spring 2025

Week 4 of Instruction

February 3, 2025

This is a summary of Spring 2025 semester activity as of Monday, February 3, 2025; trend figures are normalized relative to the first day of instruction for Spring term. Students enrolling in short and late start classes will continue to drive additional enrollment until the end of the term.

Year-over-year course registration trends reported for the UA system, UA Anchorage, Prince William Sound College, Anchorage Campus and the UAA School of Education are impacted by UAA business practice refinements¹. Closing Outlook

Student credit hour registration is expected to increase almost 4 percent (about 6,200 SCH) over last year, reaching nearly 170,000 SCH by the end of term. Approximately 3,300 additional students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Spring 2025, for a total headcount of about 21,300 students, a decrease of nearly 190 students from Spring 2024.

At this point, more than four out of five students who will likely enroll by the end of Spring 2025 have registered in an estimated 95 percent of Spring 2025 student credit hours (SCH). Following the deadline for students to drop full semester-length classes for a full refund, occurring Friday, January 24, 2025, universities may elect to drop students for non-payment. As a result, student credit hours for Spring 2024 and Spring 2025 each fell slightly from the value reported two weeks ago, a normal pattern. Course Registration

As of February 3, 2025, 18,019 students had registered for 161,363 Spring semester credit hours, system-wide. This represents an approximately 2 percent decrease in headcount (267 students) and a near 4 percent increase in student credit hour registration (5,681 SCH) from the levels observed at the start of Spring 2024. UAA student headcount decreased about 4 percent (449 students) and student credit hours grew almost 3 percent (2,592 SCH) compared to last year. UAF student headcount was nearly 4 percent higher (241 students) and student credit hour registration was just over 6 percent higher (3,394 SCH) than Spring 2024. UAS headcount was almost 4 percent lower (75 students) and student credit hour registration decreased about 2 percent (304 SCH) compared to this time last year.

About four percent of registered students (753 individuals) are taking classes concurrently at multiple universities within the system. See page 2 for additional detail about underlying student headcount and student credit hour changes by academic unit and campus.

Admissions

More than 3,250 students applied and were accepted for admission in Spring 2025, up approximately 7 percent (221 individuals) from this time last year. About 60 percent of applicants admitted to undergraduate programs and 80 percent of those admitted to graduate level programs have elected to enroll so far. Information quantifying the revenue resulting from tuition and fees, net of student aid, will be developed and included in future reports.

¹ Starting in 2024, UAA reclassified select for-credit courses to non-credit status, and they are no longer reported in Banner. As of Spring 2024 opening, these courses accounted for 11 and 6 percent of UAA and total UA System headcount, respectively, as well as 3 and 2 percent of UAA and total UA System student credit hour registration, respectively.

Non-credit courses and courses administered in other student information systems other than Banner are not included. *Year-over-year course registration trends reported for the UA system, UA Anchorage, Prince William Sound College, Anchorage Campus and the UAA School of Education are impacted by recent UAA business practice refinements. These include reclassification of select for-credit courses to non-credit status as well as a transition of 500 level, for-credit professional development courses to a separate student information system, Genius, designed for professional development students. As of Spring 2024 opening, these courses constituted 11 and 6 percent of UAA and total UA System headcount, respectively, as well as 3 and 2 percent of UAA and total UA System SCH, respectively. Spring 2024 semester instruction began Tuesday January 16, 2024 and Spring 2025 semester instruction began Monday January 13, 2025. Comparable dates relative to each university's weeks to start of instruction are reported, and if not available the closest comparable date is selected. 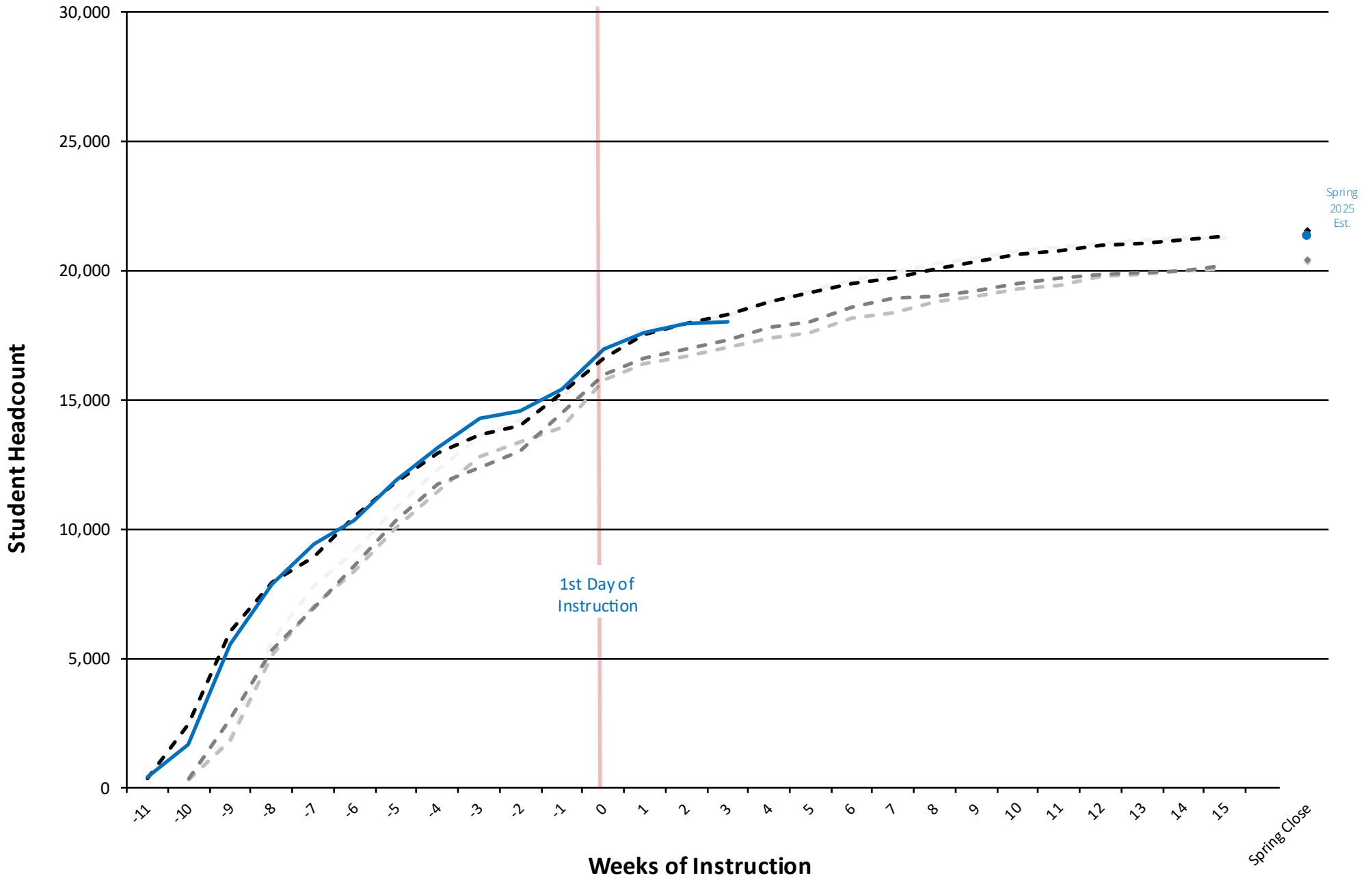
