

Admissions, Course Registration, and Billed Revenue

Fall 2024 Semester - September 23, 2024

The information below compares preliminary Fall 2024 and 2023 semester activity five weeks after the first day of instruction and provides a working estimate of final Fall 2024 closing enrollment levels.

Course Registration

Year-over-year course registration trends reported for the UA system, UA Anchorage, Prince William Sound College, Anchorage Campus and the UAA School of Education are impacted by recent UAA business practice refinements*. For more information about course registration changes by campus and academic unit, see page 2.

More than nine out of ten students who will eventually enroll by December have registered so far, accounting for an estimated 97 percent of closing Fall 2024 student credit hours (SCH). Students enrolling in short and late start classes will generate additional headcount and credit hours through the end of the term. More than 1,700 additional students are anticipated to enroll by the close of Fall 2024 for a total of nearly 20,490, a decrease of approximately 1 percent (~255 students) from Fall 2023 closing. Student credit hour registration is also expected to increase roughly 4,500 SCH by the end of the term, reaching almost 176,600 SCH and representing an increase of more than 3.5 percent (approximately 6,100 SCH) from Fall 2023. As of September 23, 2024, 18,778 students had registered for 172,082 fall semester credit hours, system wide. This represents a negligible change (a 118-student decrease) in headcount and a 4 percent (6,577 SCH) increase in student credit hour registration over this time last year.

As of week 5, UAA student headcount was 3.3 percent (366 students) lower and student credit hour registration 4 percent (3,773 SCH) higher than last year at this time. UAF headcount was 2.8 percent (191 students) higher and student credit hours 4.5 percent (2,625 SCH) more compared to Fall 2023, to-date. UAS headcount increased 6.7 percent (128 students) and student credit hour registration rose by 1.3 percent (179 SCH) year-over-year. Billed Net Tuition and Fees – Estimated Revenue

Currently, total net tuition and fee revenue is up approximately 7 percent (\$4.3M) system wide compared to Fall 2023. Undergraduate tuition revenue increased about 5 percent (\$1.8M) and graduate tuition revenue increased almost 9 percent (\$0.5M) compared to last year. UAA revenue is up 7 percent (\$2.3M) and UAF revenue is up almost 9 percent (\$2.0M). UAS revenue has maintained nearly the same level observed at this time last year. Applications

Over 13,235 applications were initiated by prospective students for Fall 2024, up 20.1 percent (2,214) from Fall 2023. Of these, 4,686 applicants were accepted and enrolled in Fall 2024 classes, an increase of 4.8 percent (215 entering students) over last year. 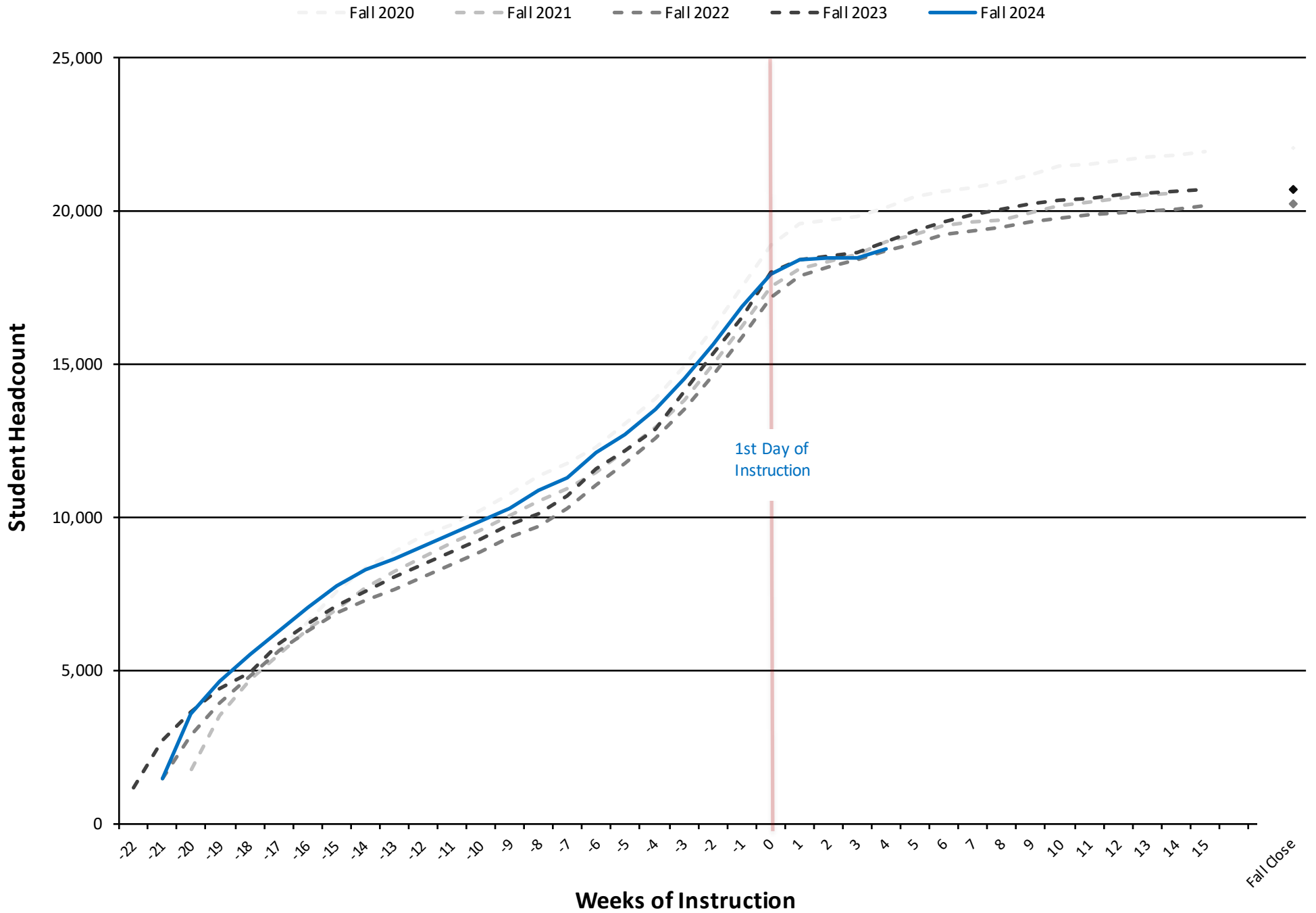
