## Preliminary Course Enrollment and Estimated Revenue Activity as of August 5, 2024 Near End of Term Summer 2023 and Summer 2024 Semester

This report is a near end of term summary for summer semester course enrollment and estimated revenue activity as of August 5, 2024. At UAA and UAS, the summer semester ended August 3, 2024, and UAF summer semester will end August 10, 2024. Adjustments have been made to summer 2023 data to account for changes in Professional and Continuing Education at UAA to allow for valid trend analysis<sup>2</sup>.

### **Course Registration**

As of Monday, 6,691 students had registered for 34,266 student credit hours (SCH) for summer, representing year-over-year growth of 460 students (7 percent) and 2,401 SCH (8 percent). Summer 2024 growth can largely be attributed to UAA, which accounted for nearly 86 percent of systemwide SCH and 78 percent of systemwide headcount growth. For Summer 2024, UAF accounted for 6 percent of systemwide SCH and 11 percent of systemwide headcount growth this summer.

UAA students registered for 2,054 (13 percent) more SCH and the headcount of students registered at UAA for Summer 2024 was 12 percent (357 students) higher than last year. Kenai Peninsula College accounted for over half of UAA SCH growth this summer.

An additional 56 students registered for UAF summer courses, representing growth of 2 percent from last year. UAF students enrolled in an additional 152 SCH this summer, a 1 percent increase over Summer 2023. Additional course registration (368 SCH) at the College of Liberal Arts offset declines in other units for Summer 2024.

The number of UAS students registering for Summer 2024 semester was also up from last year, with 55 additional students (8 percent) registering for an additional 195 SCH (6 percent). Increased registration in School of Education courses accounts for the growth in UAS SCH, year-over-year.

### **Billed Tuition and Fees - Estimated Revenue**

Total net tuition and fees billed to registered students was up almost 10 percent (\$1.2M) over last year. Each university has shown growth in projected net revenue, year-over-year: UAA grew nearly 12 percent (\$739.02 thousand); UAF was up almost 8 percent (\$331.6 thousand); and UAS was up by nearly 6 percent (\$84.9 thousand). Of the approximately \$1.2M increase in total net tuition and fees billed to registered students for Summer 2024, increases in undergraduate tuition accounted for 43 percent (\$506.9 thousand), the non-resident tuition differential accounted for 37 percent (\$439.8 thousand), and graduate tuition for 24 percent (\$290.3 thousand).
