


Student Trends - Fall 2020

University of Alaska is the state's system for providing higher education, with three distinct, accredited universities. In the last few years UA has experienced some enrollment declines and in response is moving forward to maintain the highest quality programs while resizing and stabilizing. UA is fundamental to Alaska's economic recovery, delivering relevant programs that qualify graduates to take current and future jobs in the state. Last year, about 1 in 10 Alaska workers were graduates of UA Anchorage, UA Fairbanks or UA Southeast. In fall semester 2020, UAA, UAF and UAS enrolled the equivalent of more than 4 percent of Alaska's adult population. Five-year student credit hour, enrollment and degree award trends are summarized below; detailed one-year trends by academic unit, campus and university follow on the next page.

Student headcount fell 24 percent in the last five years, with half the loss (12 percent) occurring last year following the COVID pandemic. Non-degree seeking student headcount remained relatively steady between fall 2016 and fall 2019, however dropped about 20 percent by fall 2020, reflecting this group's higher sensitivity to economic instability. Degree-seeking enrollment was not impacted as much in the last year; undergraduate degree-seekers fell 9 percent from fall 2019 to fall 2020, and the number of graduate degree-seekers declined 1 percent.

Student Credit Hours Delivered

While total enrollment declined, the ratio of annual graduates to enrolled students each fall improved from 1:6 in 2016 to 1:5 in 2020, meaning a higher proportion of enrolled students earned a degree. Overall, the number of degrees awarded fell 11 percent in the last five years, with very little decline (1 percent) in the last year. Bachelor's and associate level degree awards have started to rebound in the last year growing 1 percent and 7 percent, respectively; graduate program awards are projected to pick up soon as well. Of program graduates remaining in Alaska one year after graduation, 90 percent were employed in-state.

Total student credit hours declined 26 percent in the last five years, from roughly 250,000 credit hours in fall 2016 to about 185,000 in fall 2020. COVID-19 accounted for about one-third of the overall loss in the last five years, with student credit hours dropping 10 percent between fall 2019 and fall 2020. Anchorage, Fairbanks and Juneau campuses deliver about three-quarters of total UA credit hours; in fall 2020 these campuses delivered 25 percent fewer credit hours than in fall 2016, and 8 percent fewer than in fall 2019. Community campus credit hour enrollment was especially impacted by the pandemic, dropping about 15 percent in the last year.
