




Student Loan Indebtedness by Student Outcome Category

Highlights include:


- On average across all fall cohorts from 2001 to 2006, 42 percent of bachelor degree seeking, first-time, full-time freshmen received loans during their undergraduate career. Out of those who took loans, 34 percent stopped out, 9 percent earned a 2-year degree as their first degree, 36 percent earned a 4-year degree as their first degree, 19 percent transferred to a non-UA institution, and 2 percent were still enrolled at UA during fall 2012 (Table 1b and 1c).
- Of the students who stopped out, almost two-fifths of undergraduate degree-seeking students received loans, on average.
- Regardless of degree seeking status, the greatest proportion of students stopped out after their first year, with an average loan debt of more than \$3,500 (Table 3a and 3b).
- About 54 percent of the bachelor degree seeking, first-time, full-time freshmen who entered UA between fall 2001 and fall 2006 and did not graduate or transfer to a non-UA institution accumulated at most \$6,000 in loan debt by their first stop out. An additional 15 percent accrued more than \$20,000 in loan debt (Figure 1 and Table 4a).

- For 2-year students who began attending UA during the same time frame, 61 percent also accumulated at most \$6,000 in loan debt by their first stop out and 9 percent had more than \$20,000 in loan debt (Figure 2 and Table 4b).

- Comparatively, on average, 44 percent of 2-year degree seeking, first-time, full-time freshmen received loans during their undergraduate career. From these students, 53 percent stopped out, 21 percent earned a 2-year degree as their first degree, 9 percent earned a 4-year degree as their first degree, 16 percent transferred out of UA, and 1 percent was still enrolled at UA for fall 2012 (Table 2b and 2c).
- On average, 47 percent of the 4-year degree-seeking students who earned a degree at UA received loans, having an average cumulative loan debt of \$25,500 upon graduation (Tables 1b and 3a). Of the 2-year degree-seeking students who earned a degree at UA, nearly 55 percent received loans, and their average loan debt amounted to slightly less than \$24,000, on average (Tables 2b and 3b).
- Of the 4-year degree-seeking students who transferred to a non-UA institution, on average 36 percent received loans prior to transferring, accumulating an average of nearly \$8,500 in loan debt (Tables 1b and 3a). About 43 percent 2-year degree-seeking students who transferred also received loans, accruing an average of about \$7,000 (Tables 2b and 3b).

Methodology Notes:

First, retention and graduation was adapted from methodology previously developed for the Consortium for Student Retention Data Exchange (CSRDE) survey, which considers cumulative retention and graduation rates for first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking freshmen. Retention is on a fall-to-fall basis. Once a student receives a degree, the student is no longer considered in retention, regardless of whether the student continues enrolling at UA.

For students who earned at least one undergraduate degree, their first degree was considered and determined to be either a 2-year or a 4-year degree. For students who earned multiple degrees in the same year, the highest degree earned was considered.

For students, who did not earn a degree at UA, it was determined whether they transferred to a non-UA institution after their first stop-out, which corresponds to the first fall term for which a student was not retained at UA.

Cumulative debt is calculated through the year an undergraduate degree was earned or the year a student first stopped out. Loan debt for continuing students who have not yet earned a degree is not considered.
