## Summary: Degrees Awarded to UA Scholars, Alaska Performance Scholarship Recipients & Alaska Education Grant Recipients

The UA Scholars program awards a four-year scholarship to the top 10 percent of Alaska high school graduates. The Alaska Performance Scholarship (APS) is awarded to students based on key academic performance indicators in high school. The Alaska Educational Grant (AEG) provides need-based financial aid to eligible Alaskan students attending qualifying postsecondary institutions in Alaska.

UA students can receive more than one of these scholarships or grants simultaneously, so an individual may be counted in one, two, or all three aid recipient groups discussed here.

UA Scholars earned 10.5 percent (344) of the degrees and certificates awarded in FY24 (Table 1). Alaska Performance Scholarship recipients earned 19.8 percent (650) of FY24 degrees, while Alaska Educational Grant recipients earned approximately 13.9 percent (456) (Tables 4 and 7).

The number of degrees and certificates earned by all three scholarship recipient groups declined over the last five years. Moderate declines in program completions were expected due to decreased enrollment during the pandemic. The number of degrees awarded to UA Scholars increased in the last fiscal year, but APS and AEG recipients did not experience the same recovery. With enrollment now stabilized, program completions are expected to increase in the future.

From FY20 to FY24, the number of degrees earned by UA Scholars dropped by 30.5 percent (151 degrees) but increased by 8.9 percent (28 degrees) between FY23 and FY24 (Table 1). The number of credentials earned by APS recipients in FY24 decreased by 31.1 percent (294 degrees) since FY20 and by 6.1 percent (42 degrees) from FY23 (Table 4). Since FY20, the number of degrees awarded to AEG recipients decreased by 44.3 percent (362 degrees), including a 6.4 percent decrease (31 degrees) in the last year (Table 7).

The top disciplines for degrees awarded in FY24 were similar across UA Scholars, APS, and AEG recipients. Among UA Scholars who earned a degree or certificate in FY24, three disciplines accounted for 48.5 percent (167 degrees) of awards: Health (64 awards, 18.6 percent), Business and Public Administration (58 awards, 16.9 percent), and Letters, Communication, and Philosophy (45 awards, 13.1 percent) (Table 2). For APS recipients, three disciplines made up 51.2 percent (333 degrees) of awards: Business and Public Administration (125 awards, 19.2 percent), Health (106 awards, 16.3 percent), and Letters, Communication, and Philosophy (102 awards, 15.7 percent) (Table 5). For AEG recipients, the top three disciplines accounted for 60.1 percent (274 degrees) of awards in FY24: Business and Public Administration (113 awards, 24.8 percent), Health (108 awards, 23.7 percent), and Letters, Communication, and Philosophy (53 awards, 11.6 percent) (Table 8).

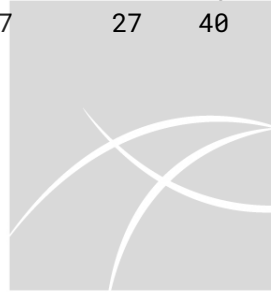

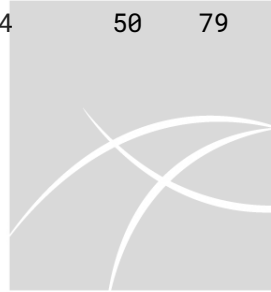

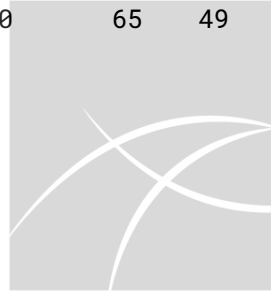

Note: Student demographic information is self-reported. UA utilizes an unduplicated race categorization, although students often identify as more than one race/ethnicity. This compilation method allows each student to be counted uniquely. For example, if a student declares as Alaska Native and White, that person would be recorded as one Alaska Native student, for a total headcount of one.
