Summary: Financial Aid and Costs for All Students

In Aid Year (AY) 2023-24, 10,324 degree-seeking students and 984 non-degree-seeking students received at least one type of financial aid system wide (Table 4). This includes grants, scholarships, loans, and some tuition waivers. Institutional tuition discounts such as the Western Undergraduate Exchange and the Come Home Alaska discount, as well as tuition and fee waivers associated with university employment, are not categorized as financial aid.


Over the last five years, total financial aid distributions to UA students decreased by 11.3 percent (\$12.7 million), from \$111.9 million in AY2019-20 to \$99.3 million in AY2023-24. In the last year, financial aid distributions increased 3.9 percent (\$3.8 million) from \$94.5 million in AY2022-23 to \$99.3 million in AY2023-24. Grant awards increased by 5.2 percent (\$1.1 million) in the last year, while scholarship awards increased 10.6 percent (\$4.3 million). Tuition and fee waivers decreased 61.9 percent (\$1.4 million) in the last year. Federal student financial aid paid to students increased by 1.0 percent (\$470 thousand) in the last year. Financial aid paid to students from private sources increased by 15.5 percent (\$1.1 million) over this same period (Table 2).

To receive financial aid, a student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. Alaska high school seniors complete the FAFSA at the lowest rate in the country, with only 25.8 percent of 2023-24 seniors submitting a complete application by July 2024, a 2.2 percentage point decrease from the previous year's submission rate¹.

Need-based financial aid award amounts have decreased by 8.9 percent (\$2.2 million) since AY2019-20. However, in the last year, these award amounts increased by 5.6 percent (\$1.2 million). This increase was observed at each university, with UAA increasing by 4.5 percent (\$542.3) thousand), UAF by 7.7 percent (\$609.5 thousand), and UAS by 3.9 percent (\$64.2 thousand).
