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## Summary: Retention Rates

The retention rate for first-time, full-time students enrolled in fall semester is defined as the proportion of the group who return the following fall. University level retention considers students who re-enroll for credit at the same university the following fall, and UA System level retention considers students who re-enroll for credit at any university the following fall.

Covid's impact on the retention rates varied depending on degree level and scholarships. Firsttime full-time freshmen retention rate declined 2 percentage points total for entries in fall 2019, fall 2020 and fall 2021. UA Scholar retention rate increased from fall 2019 to fall 2021 by 1.4 percentage points (Table 2.01a). During that time, Indigenous students' retention declined by 3 percentage points (Table 2.01a1). Among bachelor's degree-seeking students, UA Scholars retention improved by 1.2 percentage points during fall 2020 to fall 2021 (Table 2.01b). Indigenous students enrolled in two-year programs had steady retention gains starting fall 2019 and continuing to fall 2023 with a total of 6.7 percentage points gained (Table 2.01c1). Some retention rates now align with pre-Covid levels while others have reached all-time, or five-year highs.

In the last five years, the retention of freshmen seeking any degree increased from 63.0 percent to 66.8 percent (Table 2.01a). During this time span, the retention rate of Indigenous students seeking any degree increased from 51.1 percent to 55.4 percent (Table 2.01a1). Both the overall retention rate and Indigenous retention rate are five-year highs. According to the most recent nationwide retention data, 58.7 percent of students at public, four-year, open-enrollment institutions who started in fall 2020 returned in fall 2021 (NCES 2022<sup>1</sup>). In comparison, for the same period, the UA System's retention rate was 65.8 percent overall (Table 2.01a).

Within two-year programs, 57.0 percent of associate degree-seeking freshmen were retained from fall 2022 to fall 2023, which is approximately 5 percentage points higher than the retention rate of this group from fall 2021 to fall 2022 (Table 2.01c). Associate degree-seekers retention rates are at all-time highs across the board. Nearly 28 percent of certificate and occupational endorsement seeking freshmen were retained between fall 2022 and fall 2023. This is 4 percentage points lower than the retention rate in the previous year (Table 2.01d). Within four-year programs, from fall 2022 to fall 2023, nearly 73.1 percent of bachelor seeking freshmen were retained, which was a 2.5 percentage point increase from the rate in fall 2021 to fall 2022 and puts this year's retention rate at a five-year high (Table 2.01b).

Among Indigenous associate degree-seeking freshmen, 48.4 percent of those entering in fall 2022 returned in fall 2023. This is an increase of 2.1 percentage points from the previous year, and an all-time high (Table 2.01c1). During this same time span, Indigenous freshmen seeking a certificate or occupation endorsement had a retention rate for 10.5 percent which is a 16.2 percentage point decrease from the previous year (Table 2.01d1). At the bachelor's degree-seeking level, Indigenous students who started in fall 2022 and were retained for fall 2023 at a rate of 64 percent which is 6.1 percentage points higher than the previous year (Table 2.01b1).
