Summary: Financial Aid and Costs for All Students

In Aid Year (AY) 2022-22, 10,297 degree-seeking students and 963 non-degree seeking students received at least one type of financial aid, system wide. This includes grants, scholarships and loans, and some tuition waivers. Institutional tuition discounts such as the Western Undergraduate Exchange and the Come Home Alaska discount, as well as tuition and fee waivers associated with university employment are not categorized as financial aid.

Over the last five years, the UA system recorded a decline in total financial aid distributions to students. The total amount of aid paid to students decreased by 20 percent, from \$119.3 million in AY2018-19 to \$95.5 million in AY2022-23. Most of this drop occurred in the last year, with a 15 percent decrease (\$17.2 million) in financial aid distributed to students over the previous year. (Table 4.13). Grant awards dropped 41 percent (\$14.6 million) in the last year, and tuition and fee waiver awards fell 45 percent (\$1.5 million) over this time.

Federal student financial aid paid to students fell 27 percent (\$16.7 million) in the last year. Financial aid paid to students from private sources grew 42 percent (\$2.2 million) over this same period.

To receive any financial aid, a student must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA ®) form. Alaska high school seniors complete the FAFSA at the lowest rate of any state, with 28 percent of 2022-23 high school seniors submitting a complete application by June 2023, although up slightly from 2021-221.

For individuals already attending a postsecondary institution nationally, 66 percent complete a FAFSA on average. Most UA students apply for the FAFSA², with 65 percent of UAA degree seeking students having a FAFSA on record, 61 percent of UAF students and 55 percent of UAS students.






