### Banner Student Face-to-Face Recap

We discussed points of interest in the Cat & Sched sessions.

UAF's new catalog download SCR2DNF is in LrgP and uses level, so other MAUs are welcome to try it. For preregs it keys off PR# rather than scapreg.

Jeff mentioned the addition of 3 new Instruc Method codes:

AB Audio/Blackboard combined

**BB** Blackboard

**EL Elluminate live** 

UAA also added some of these to their rooms values.

Open Learning: Jeff and Lora have had some success with this. Jeff recommends doing setup at the college level. SSASECT, SSARULE "% of Completion" requires a negative value to allow students to register before class begins. Jeff will keep us updated on progress with Open Learning testing.

Jeff mentioned that the F2F was a good reminder that we all do similar work, and any shared items may help others. He volunteered to send info to the CCS list on some of the macros he uses, which might well be useful to the rest of us. Thank you Jeff!

### Old Business:

Colleen reminds us to code Non-credit and CEU courses for both credit hours and contact hours on both scacrse and ssasect. Institutional Research will begin tracking these hours as "instructional productivity" for budget purposes by Fall 09 or sooner if ready.

## **New Business**

• From Linda: Catalog coding of allowable course hours.

The problem seems to be in the SCACRSE form in Banner itself. We have a number of courses in our catalog where, for example, a 1-credit course may be taken as a 1-hour lecture or a 3-hour lab. So, we would like to have it appear on Banner and in the catalog download as 1+0 or 0+3 for contact hours. However, Banner will not permit me to enter 1+0 because I get an error code that says "ERROR Low hours must be less than high hours." What happens is I must enter it as 0+1 or 0+3, which results in inaccurate information. The course may not be taken for (no lecture) one hour of lab or three hours of lab, it must be taken as one hour of lecture (zero lab) or (zero lecture) three hours of lab.

What I believe would fix it is to change Banner to allow us to enter a high hour number preceding a low hour number.

I hadn't realized this was happening, and it results in an unintelligible mess for many of our courses. It must be fixed in Banner so it will appear correctly in the UAOnline course catalog as well as the download for the printed catalog. I look forward to discussion at a future meeting.

Thank you, Linda

Patrick was attending and after discussion it was decided Linda would send Pat the courses to code, as users are unable to code Banner in that way. Example given: CIOS A082 effective term 200201.

### Department Header Text

Linda brought up the subject of department header text, as coded on SCATEXT pertaining to a subject/department. It was agreed that this information would be very helpful to be displayed on UAOnline with the header itself, at the top of the Class Schedule Listing results page, just as it would in a published schedule. All liked the suggestion and Linda will draft a Task Request.

Patrick will prepare static html pages, and will post them to the CCS list for approval before these go to the programmers. After approval of the html's, they will be built in LrgPrep.
