I. Chair's Report

- A. Distance education and general coding discussion – continue looking at instructional method codes, the goal being to agree on their definition and how to use them.
Remaining codes:

Definitions agreed to by all campuses present:

MM Multimedia – Instruction that requires other media usage (i.e., videos, CD ROMs, DVDs, audiotapes)

PW Partially web-based – Code not used very much and it was agreed that BD should cover this. Agreed to not use this code and will pursue having “DO NOT USE” added to the description.

SL Live Broadcast by Satellite – Students will view this via TV, but the important part is that this is live delivery.

TV Television Delivery – Not delivered live but still viewed on TV.

VC Video Conference – Delivered by video conference.

VW Video Conference & Web-based – Delivered by combination of video conference and web.

WB Web-based – discussion started from a position of “web-based delivery other than eLive or Blackboard” but was tabled so that additional discussion with community campuses could happen.
