I. Chair's Report

A. Scripting session with Colleen went well and was very helpful. Thanks to all who were able to attend.

- B. It looks like we'll get the new DUPL checking override element in LRGP to test approximately three weeks after the Banner changes go into LRGP (estimated to be 11/16/10). Will keep you updated on how the timeline shakes out. We will have to send SunGard a test plan, similar to what we've had to do for the SSASECT changes. Please take a look at it when it goes out. Discussion: Many campuses use CLAS for classroom meetings of any kind. In general, other campuses said that they would not use the new code (whatever it ended up being), but were not opposed to it if it was helpful to Matsu. There was no option to adding a new meeting type code.

Group agreed to use PRIN as the new code. It will refer to classes with a meeting type of practicum or internship. Sarah will email sdsit to request that it be added.
