I. Chair's Report

SSRROLL programming issue FYI:

Some parameters in our current SSR9OLL will allow you to add multiple values AND a wildcard (%). The search then ignores the wildcard and just gives results for the actual values that have been entered. For example: If Subject code value of ENGL, ECON and % are entered, then the process will roll all CRNs for ENGL and ECON.

In the new version off SSRROLL from SunGard, it will work the opposite way. If a multiple values and wildcard are entered, then the roll process will run based on the wildcard, essentially ignoring the other values. For example: If Subject code value of ENGL, ECON and % are entered, then the process will roll all CRNs (all subjects).
