Banner

Banner 8.6 General Upgrade:

- Currently in LRGP
- 9/29 PROD
- Will require test plan from each MAU's functional areas

New Business

UAOnline Single Sign-On: please test.

UAOnline LRGP has been configured to allow Single Sign-On (SSO) connections. This will allow users to login with their UA Username and University Password.

The following link has been added to the UAOnline LRGP Login page:

To go directly to the SSO page for UAOnline LRGP, use this link:

Both the old UAOnline LRGP login page and the new UAOnline SSO page will work. So, users can select to login with their UA ID and PIN, or UA Username and University Password. PROD will be configured similarly at first, but the PIN will be disabled in PROD on October 13, 2013.

The old Login page and PINs will continue to be allowed through LRGP to make it easier for functional users to claim accounts for testing UAOnline.

The SSO login and logout pages are not branded for UA yet, but will be soon. These changes will be cosmetic and should not hold up testing.

Use ELMO LRGP to claim an account for testing LRGP SSO. There is a link to ELMO LRGP on the UAOnline LRGP Login page, but the direct link is:

- 1) Go to ELMO LRGP. Login with username and password (old password, in my case) then I followed prompts and on the last screen did the password reset.
- 2) Go to either of the UAOnline LRGP links in the email below - I did [click here](#).
- 3) Enter username and password at UAOnline LRGP, and you are in.
