The University of Alaska ("University") intends to issue, at fair market value, a temporary construction permit authorizing the use of University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF) managed lands to install a fiber optic line. The fiber optic will support the Cold Climate Housing Research Center facility located off Draanjik Drive in Fairbanks. The permit term is less than one year and will be followed by an easement.
